Summary of findings

Overall summary

About the service

Heatherfield Care Home is a nursing care home providing personal and nursing care to up to 74 people. There were 72 people living there at the time of this inspection, including younger people with physical disabilities, people with nursing needs and people living with dementia.

We found the following examples of good practice.

There were appropriate measures in place to prevent visitors from spreading infection. All visitors had to wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), sanitise their hands, complete a track and trace form and had their temperature checked prior to entering the home.

The provider was following national guidance for anyone moving into the home and new admissions were carried out safely.

The home was divided into three distinct units with PPE stations at each crossing point which helped to prevent cross infection. People isolating in the dementia care unit had their own dedicated care and housekeeping staff who supported all their needs.

There was PPE at frequent places throughout the home and clear signage was in place regarding the correct use of PPE. Staff had received appropriate infection prevention and control training.

At the time of this visit, local restrictions on non-essential visiting were in place so alternative measures such as telephone and video calls were being used.

The premises were very clean. Additional cleaning was taking place including frequently touched surfaces such as handrails.

We were assured that this service met good infection prevention and control guidelines.

Detailed findings

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of coronavirus, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 29 October 2020 and was announced.
