Summary of findings

Overall summary

Baycroft Fairfield is a 'care home' providing accommodation, nursing and personal care for up to 75 people. At the time of our inspection there were 10 people using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

There was a designated area for visits to take place. Additional systems had been applied to support people with maintaining contact with family and friends which included window visits, use of computer tablets, telephone calls, use of social media and garden visits.

Internal training had been provided to all staff on how to wear, put on and take off personal protective equipment (PPE). This was continuously monitored by the registered manager and discussed during team meetings and supervision. In addition, formal competency checks were completed to ensure staff applied safe practice.

The provider had produced a safety and well-being guide for people and their families. This provided information in a pictorial format advising of the measures that the provider had taken during the COVID-19 pandemic to mitigate risk.

Detailed findings

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the COVID-19 pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 16 April 2021 and was announced. The inspection was announced prior to us entering the home, so we could ensure that measures were in place to support an inspection and manage any infection control risks. We also asked the provider to send us infection prevention and control policies and audit findings.
