## Summary of findings

### **Overall summary**

Goddard Avenue (145) is a care home. People in care homes receive accommodation and nursing or personal care as a single package under one contractual agreement. CQC regulates both the premises and the care provided, and both were looked at during this inspection.

Goddard Avenue (145) provides care and accommodation for up to 12 people who have a learning disability and/or mental health support needs. The home is comprised of two separate adjoining houses. At the time of our inspection there were 12 people using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

People contributed to a newsletter sharing their thoughts about the pandemic and reinforcing current practices such as social distancing.

Discussions were held with people to remind them of why staff were wearing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

Regular testing was in place for people using the service and staff. The service was proactive in arranging extra testing for people where it was felt they may have been at risk of infection.

Meal times had been arranged so that people could social distance through use of other rooms and staggered meal times.

Staff were provided with support and information to enable them to continue to work through the pandemic.

Regular audits ensured the service was prepared to continue to meet the challenges of the pandemic.

# Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are conducting a thematic review of infection control and prevention measures in care homes.

The service was selected to take part in this thematic review which is seeking to identify examples of good practice in infection prevention and control.
