Overall summary

Park House Nursing Home is a residential nursing home in the Queensbury area of Bradford. The home provides accommodation, personal care and nursing care for older people and people living with dementia. At the time of our inspection there were 21 people using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

• There have been no positive cases of COVID 19 in the home during the pandemic.

• New admissions are tested for COVID 19 and the results are known before they are admitted to the home. All new admissions are isolated to their rooms for 14 days.

• The home is in local lockdown and currently closed to visitors. Staff support people to keep in touch with family and friends through video and phone calls and closed window visits.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place. As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are conducting a thematic review of infection control and prevention measures in care homes.
