Summary of findings

Overall summary

Claremont Care Home is a residential nursing home in Leeds. The home provides accommodation, personal care and nursing care for older people and people living with dementia. At the time of our inspection there were 53 people using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

- Visitors were asked questions about their COVID-19 status upon entering the building, and on entry were provided with PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) and had their temperature taken.

Detailed findings

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place. As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are conducting a thematic review of infection control and prevention measures in care homes.

This inspection took place on 27 August 2020 and was announced. The service was selected to take part in this thematic review which is seeking to identify examples of good practice in infection prevention and control.

Our findings

S5 How well are people protected by the prevention and control of infection?

- We were somewhat assured that the provider was preventing visitors from catching and spreading infections.
- We were somewhat assured that the provider was accessing testing for people using the service and staff, regular testing had not yet been made fully available to the service however, whole home testing had been undertaken.
- We were assured that the provider was promoting safety through the layout and hygiene practices of the premises.
- We were somewhat assured that the provider was making sure infection outbreaks could be effectively prevented or managed.
- We were somewhat assured that the provider's infection prevention and control policy and practice was up to date.

We have signposted the provider to resources to develop their approach.
