The provider is registered with CQC to deliver the Regulated Activities; diagnostic and screening procedures, maternity and midwifery services, treatment of disease, disorder or injury and family planning. The provider has one location. The practice is situated within the Sutton Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and delivers (Personal Medical Services (PMS). The practice is part of a wider network of GP practices within the Carshalton Primary Network.

The practice has approximately 4800 patients. The ethnicity of most patients is white British. There are approximately 11% of Asian patients, 5% black patients, 4% mixed race patients and 1% other white patients. The practice population is on the 8th decile for deprivation (with 10 being the least deprived), and lower than average on measures of income deprivation affecting older people and children.

The clinical team at the practice is made up of two part-time male GP Partners, a salaried female GP and two long term locum GPs. One female practice nurse and a female healthcare assistant. The non-clinical team at the practice is made up of a practice manager, a business manager and a team of administrative and reception staff members.

When the practice is closed patients are directed to contact the local out of hours provider.
