Summary of findings

Overall summary

Priory House had been identified as a designated service to admit people with a COVID 19 positive result. Some of the service had previously been inspected as a designated service and this inspection focused on adding a further six beds to make it a 12 bedded unit in total. This would be separate from the main service with separate facilities and staff.

We found the following examples of good practice:

The registered manager had followed government and Department of Health guidelines to set up a standalone unit within an established service.

Appropriate alterations had been made to the service to mitigate risk and keep people safe. The registered manager had implemented protocols to ensure infection control procedures were followed by staff.

Staff had received additional training in infection prevention control, COVID-19 and the correct use of PPE. A dedicated team of staff had been identified to work solely on the unit and sufficient measures were in place to support, train and oversee agency staff members working on the unit. There was a Clinical Lead at the service who offered additional training and support to staff and worked alongside them to share best practice. Staff had been provided with facilities to safely work and rest whilst maintaining social distance.

The registered manager had formed good working relationships with other health professionals and the local hospital staff to support people with a person-centred pathway to be admitted to the service.

During people's stay, their well-being was supported with access to their own television and radio and the facility to video call relatives.

We were assured that this service met good infection prevention and control guidelines as a designated care setting.

Detailed findings

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place. As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are conducting a review of infection control and prevention measures in care homes.

The service had been identified for use by the Local Authority as a designated care setting in response to the Winter Plan for people discharged from hospital with a positive Covid-19 status. This inspection was to ensure that the service was compliant with infection control and prevention measures.

This inspection took place on 18 December 2020 and was announced.
