Summary of findings

Overall summary

Chapelfields is a care home providing nursing and personal care to 46 people at the time of the inspection. The service can support up to 70 people.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The environment was clean and hygienic with an enhanced cleaning schedule in place to minimise the spread of infection. Staff wore appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) and had their competency to use this assessed on a regular basis.

All visitors to the service have checks on their temperature and were required to complete a questionnaire in line with current COVID-19 guidelines.

Risk assessments had been devised by the service for individuals to take the risk of them being infected into account and new admissions underwent an period of isolation. All people who use the service are regularly tested and all had received a first does of vaccination. Staff are also subject to testing both prior to their shift and weekly.

Despite restrictions; people who used the service appeared relaxed, comfortable and a home-like atmosphere was sustained. Relatives had the opportunity to visit their relations in a Covid-safe environment
