Summary of findings

Overall summary

Shenstone House is a residential care home providing personal care for up to 14 people aged 65 and over. At the time of the inspection nine people were using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

People were supported to self-isolate if returning to the home from a visit to hospital for the recommended 14 days.

Staff training had been provided for good IPC practice and staff were seen to be wearing the correct PPE.

Visitors to the home were able to see their family member, in an area where social distancing was possible, in addition wearing PPE.

Staff and people were in receipt of regular COVID-19 testing and any staff displaying symptoms were asked to self-isolate at home.

The home environment was clean and free of clutter. The provider was making changes to the home and a redecoration programme was in place.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.
