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Summary of findings

Overall summary

Morley Manor is a care home in Leeds. People in care homes receive accommodation and personal care as a single package under one contractual agreement. The Care Quality Commission (CQC) regulates both the premises and the care provided, and both were looked at during this inspection. There were 27 people using the service at the time of the inspection.

We found the following examples of good practice.

We found clear infection prevention control signs reminded everyone at the point of entry and throughout the home about procedures for infection control.

The home was accessing regular testing, which had assisted them in identifying and managing an outbreak of COVID-19. All staff and people had received both their COVID-19 vaccinations.

Risks in relation to visitors had been assessed and action taken to minimise risks. At the time of the inspection the home was closed to visitors.

Staff were seen to be correctly wearing personal protective equipment (PPE).

Staff said they had been well supported by the provider during the pandemic and had been kept up to date with all the government guidance. The registered manager had moved in on the premises through COVID-19 to support staffing in the home.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of COVID-19, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe, and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 3 August 2021 and was announced.
