Summary of findings

Overall summary

Buckwood View provides accommodation for up to 18 adults who require personal or nursing care. The home specialises in supporting adults with a learning disability and the accommodation is made up of six separate bungalows. There is a large shared communal lounge and kitchen, as well as separate smaller lounges and kitchens in each bungalow. At the time of our inspection there were 13 people using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The premises were clean and well-maintained. Staff followed cleaning schedules to ensure all areas of the home were regularly cleaned, including high touch areas such as door handles and light switches.

Staff had received recent training in infection prevention and control, including how to put on and take off their personal protective equipment (PPE) in a safe manner.

We observed staff changed PPE when appropriate, and staff regularly washed and sanitised their hands.

People's rooms were individual and they all had en-suite facilities so people could be safely isolated if they became infectious.

Tests for COVID-19 were being carried out in line with good practice guidance, where possible.

Visits to the home were restricted at the time of this inspection, in accordance with local infection control guidance. During this time staff were supporting people to stay in contact with their relatives and friends via the telephone.

Background to this inspection
