Summary of findings

Overall summary

Oakview Care Home provide accommodation and nursing or personal care to up to 72 people in one building across four separate units, each of which have separate adapted facilities. Two of the units provide care and nursing care to people living with dementia. At the time of the inspection, there were 63 people using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice:

The provider was following best practice guidelines in ensuring visitors to the home did not introduce or spread COVID-19. Due to the layout of the building, in order to reduce the amount of visitors entering through the main entrance, a separate entrance was also being used for easier access to specific areas of the home and to minimise the risk of spreading infection.

Staff were adhering to Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) guidelines and extra PPE locations had been set up on each corridor. Where social distancing could not be maintained, staff took extra precautions through the use of PPE and handwashing to minimise the spread of infection.

The provider had ensured that all staff had received a personal COVID-19 risk assessment and conversations about their wellbeing were held regularly.

The care home has continued to allow visitors to enter the premises, however strict guidelines were adhered too. Visitors have to use the appropriate PPE and specific areas had been set up for people to see their visitors.

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.
