Summary of findings

Overall summary

Ottley House is a care home and provides nursing or personal care to a maximum of 72 people, older adults and people living with dementia. At the time of our visit 67 people lived at the home.

We found the following examples of good practice.

- On arrival at the home there were clear instructions for all visitors to follow. This included hand sanitising and the use of face masks. Additionally, visitors completed a rapid Covid-19 test and had their temperature checked to ensure their visit could take place safely in line with current guidance.
- People were supported to maintain contact with others who were important to them in a variety of ways including a 'visiting pod'. Use of the area meant visits took place safely which reduced the risk of cross infection.
- Some furniture in communal areas had been rearranged to encourage people to socially distance.
- Staff members were emotionally supported. This included signposting staff to a confidential helpline for advice during the pandemic.
- Staff used personal protection equipment appropriately and had access to additional supplies if needed.
- An extra staff room had been created which meant staff could appropriately socially distance during their breaks.
- The registered manager and infection prevention lead monitored staff compliance with the provider's infection control policy.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.
