Why we carried out this inspection

The CQC undertook this inspection at the same time as we inspected a range of urgent and emergency care services in Cornwall. To understand the experience of GP Providers and people who use GP services, we asked a range of questions in relation to urgent and emergency care. The responses we received have been used to inform and support system wide feedback

How we carried out the inspection

Throughout the pandemic, CQC has continued to regulate and respond to risk. However, taking into account the circumstances arising as a result of the pandemic, and in order to reduce risk, we have conducted our inspections differently.

This inspection was carried out in a way which enabled us to spend a minimum amount of time on site. This was with consent from the provider and in line with all data protection and information governance requirements.

This included:

- Conducting staff interviews using video conferencing
- Completing clinical searches on the practice's patient records system and discussing findings with the provider
- Reviewing patient records to identify issues and clarify actions taken by the provider
- · Requesting evidence from the provider
- A short site visit
- A staff questionnaire

Our inspection team

Our inspection team was led by a CQC lead inspector who spoke with staff using video conferencing facilities and undertook a site visit. The team included a GP specialist advisor who spoke with staff using video conferencing facilities and completed clinical searches and records reviews without visiting the location.

Background to Carn to Coast Health Centres Carn to Coast Health Centres is located in Redruth at: Pool Health Centre Station Road Pool Redruth Cornwall TR153DU The practice has three branch surgeries at: Homecroft Surgery, Voguebeloth, Illogan, Redruth, TR164ET Trevithick Surgery, 2-6 Basset Rd. Camborne **TR148TT** St Day Surgery, 17 Scorrier St. St Day, Redruth TR165LH Carn to Coast has also been using the Redruth Health Office, Forth Noweth, Redruth, Cornwall, TR15 1AU as a 'satellite' for the purposes of COVID-19 vaccination. the surgery.

The Homecroft Surgery also has a dispensary that is able to dispense to patients who live more than a mile away from

We did not visit any of the branch surgeries during this inspection.

The provider is registered with CQC to deliver the Regulated Activities; diagnostic and screening procedures, maternity and midwifery services, family planning and treatment of disease, disorder or injury and surgical procedures. These are delivered from all sites.

The practice offers services from sites and patients can access services at all surgeries.

The practice is situated within the Kernow Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and delivers General Medical Services (**GMS**) to a patient population of about 30,935. This is part of a contract held with NHS England.

Information published by Public Health England shows that deprivation within the practice population group is in the third-lowest decile (three of 10). The lower the decile, the more deprived the practice population is relative to others. The age distribution of the practice population closely mirrors the local and national averages. There are more male patients registered at the practice compared to females.

There is a team of eight GP partners, 10 salaried GPs and a non-clinical managing partner. The health centres have a team of seven paramedics, five nurse practitioners, two mental health practioners, five minor illness nurses and six practice nurses. The GPs are supported at the practice by a team of three managers and a team of reception and administration staff.

Due to the enhanced infection prevention and control measures put in place since the pandemic and in line with the national guidance, most GP appointments were telephone consultations. If the GP needs to see a patient face-to-face then the patient is offered a choice of either the main GP location or the branch surgery.
