Summary of findings

Overall summary

Disabilities Trust – 128 Beech Hill is a care home registered to provide accommodation and personal care to a maximum of four adults with learning disabilities. There were 4 people living at the service during our inspection.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The environment had been adapted to encourage social distancing. Communal areas were arranged to enable appropriate spacing between people.

The home was clean and tidy. Cleanliness and good infection control was maintained through the home. This included regular cleaning of areas which were frequently touched, for example door handles.

Staff were seen to be wearing appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), and there was a plentiful supply evident throughout the home.

The provider had policies and procedures for infection prevention and control, which were understood and followed by staff. All staff had received additional training in infection prevention and control and had completed regular competency checks.

Staff and people took part in a COVID-19 testing regime. The test results were clearly displayed in a folder which was checked regularly by staff to ensure the frequency of tests and results were monitored and correct.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the COVID-19 pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.
