Overall summary

We carried out an unannounced focused inspection of Church View Surgery (also known as Denaby Medical Practice) on 24 September 2021. The inspection was carried out at Mexborough Medical Practice which is the branch surgery of the provider's other location, Askern Medical Practice.

Why we carried out this inspection

This inspection was a focused inspection following information of concern about patient safety that was disclosed to the Care Quality Commission (CQC). The information was that a nurse without prescribing qualifications had been prescribing or amending prescriptions for a patient with poor mental health.

We have the power under the Health and Social Care Act 2008 (Regulated Activities) Regulations 2014 to carry out unannounced inspections. Due to the nature of the concerns that had been raised, and the potential serious impact on patient safety, we decided to carry out an unannounced focused inspection. We only inspected the areas of concern highlighted to us.

As this was a focused inspection no ratings have been given for any of the key questions. The ratings given in the previous rated inspections remain.

How we carried out the inspection

We attended Mexborough Medical Practice. The provider granted us permission to access their clinical computer system. We only accessed what was necessary in order for us to assess the accuracy of the concerns raised. We also spoke briefly to the lead GP and the operations manager.

Our findings

- We found no evidence of nurses without prescribing qualifications prescribing or amending prescriptions.

The provider is registered with the CQC to deliver the following regulated activities: Diagnostic and screening procedures, maternity and midwifery services, surgical procedures and treatment of disease, disorder or injury.

Church View Surgery is a member of NHS Doncaster Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG). It delivers commissioned services under a Personal Medical Services (PMS) contract. This is a contract between general practices and NHS England for delivering services to the local community. At the time of our inspection there were approximately 3,500 patients registered with the practice.

The provider is registered as an organisation, AMP Healthcare Limited. At the time of this inspection there was no Registered Manager. A new manager had been recruited and was due to start their employment imminently with the intention of being the CQC Registered Manager.

The provider had a team of clinicians which included GPs, nurses, health practitioners and healthcare assistants. They also had supporting management, administrative and clerical staff.

The National General Practice Profile states that 98.1% of the practice population are of white ethnicity, and 1.9% of the practice patient population are from Black, Asian and minority ethnic backgrounds. People from different ethnic backgrounds may have an increased risk of developing certain conditions.

Information published by Public Health England rates the level of deprivation within the practice population group as level one on a scale of one to ten. Level one represents the highest levels of deprivation and level ten the lowest.
