Overall summary

Fern Lea Residential Home is a care home providing personal care to up to 19 older people and people living with dementia.

We found the following examples of good practice:

- The management team had developed a helpful Covid-19 resource file for staff.
- There were robust visiting arrangements; relatives were able to visit their loved ones in the garden by prior appointment, with good safety measures in place.
- There was a stable and committed staff team, who were aware of the importance of good infection control procedures.
- The service had not taken any new admissions since the start of the Covid-19 pandemic, but there were clear procedures in place to minimise risk should anyone new move to the service.

Detailed findings

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place. As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are conducting a thematic review of infection control and prevention measures in care homes.

This inspection took place on 25 August 2020 and was announced. The service was selected to take part in this thematic review which is seeking to identify examples of good practice in infection prevention and control.
