Summary of findings

Overall summary

Elmhurst is a residential care home providing accommodation and personal care for up to 20 people. At the time of the inspection there were 13 people living at the home.

We found the following examples of good practise.

The service was accessing the government testing scheme which had assisted them to identify an outbreak quickly. The service was working with the local authority Infection Prevention and Control team and other health professionals in managing the outbreak effectively. The registered manager was visible and supportive to people and the staff team. They shared relevant government and local updates with people, staff and relatives.

When we visited the service it was closed to visitors due to COVID-19 restrictions. People were being supported to stay in touch with their relatives and friends. Plans were in place to review the use of the conservatory area of the home to facilitate future safe visiting options.

Staff had received training in infection prevention and control and how to put on and take off their personal protective equipment (PPE). During our inspection we saw staff washing and sanitising their hands frequently and using appropriate PPE in line with government guidelines. The staff changed in and out of their uniforms at the service. Uniforms were laundered at the service to reduce the risk of cross contamination.

The home was clean, well ventilated and free from malodours. The communal areas in the home had been arranged to support people with social distancing. Specialist cleaning equipment had been purchased and was used to deep clean the environment.

Detailed findings

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of coronavirus, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 24 November 2020 and was announced.
