### Summary of findings

#### Overall summary

Kingsley Nursing Home is a care home registered to provide accommodation and nursing care for to up to 25 older people. At the time of this inspection there were 20 people living at the home.

We found the following examples of good practice:

- Staff were wearing the required levels of personal protective equipment (PPE) and they disposed of used PPE safely in line with the relevant guidance.
- The home had a testing programme in place ensuring all people living there and staff were regularly offered a test.
- Staff supported family and friends to safely visit their loved ones in accordance with the relevant guidance.
- People living at the home were supported to isolate when necessary.
- Measures were in place to minimise risk, including staff changing from their outdoor clothes at the start of a shift.
- Frequent cleaning was carried out throughout the day.

#### Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 12 March 2021 and was announced.

#### Our findings
