Summary of findings

Overall summary

Northfield House Residential Home is a residential care home providing personal and nursing care to older people and people with dementia. The service can support up to 19 people, there were 18 people living at the home at the time of our inspection. Accommodation is provided over three levels, connected by a lift, and stairs.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The provider was following best practice guidance in terms of ensuring visitors to the home did not introduce and spread Covid-19. Information and instructions for visitors were clearly displayed and explained in person by the receptionist. Staff were adhering to Personl Protective Equipment (PPE) and social distancing guidance.

When the initial restrictions were lifted staff had engaged with people and their visitors and there was a unanimous decision to keep visits at the window, rather than allow them into the building, this was to help protect people. Visits were pre booked and when this was not possible people were supported to speak to their families on the phone or via video call.

The provider had assessed staff and where not safe for staff to be at work they were supported to stay at home.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.
