Overall summary

Clover House is a residential care home providing accommodation and personal care for up to 39 people. At the time of the inspection 24 people were using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

All visitors were screened for symptoms on arrival. There was signage and instructions to explain what everyone should do to ensure safety around infection control.

Alternative forms of maintaining social contact were used for friends and relatives; for example: keeping in touch using video calls.

Hand sanitisers and personal protective equipment (PPE) were situated throughout the building.

Staff were observed wearing appropriate PPE.

The service had effective processes in place so clothes were laundered safely.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of coronavirus, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 21 December 2020 and was unannounced.
