Summary of findings

Overall summary

The Laurels is a care home providing accommodation and personal care to older people, some of whom are living with dementia. The service is registered to support up to 28 people over two floors of an adapted building. There were 18 people living at The Laurels at the time of this inspection.

We found the following examples of good practice.

- The premises were clean and well maintained. The home was undergoing a refurbishment programme to update and improve the premises.
- All staff had received training in infection prevention and control and their competency was regularly checked. Staff were seen to be following correct practice in this area.
- Relatives and friends were encouraged to keep in contact with their loved ones via telephone and video calls. A safe space had been created outside to facilitate face to face visits.
- All people living and working at The Laurels had been offered a vaccine and were regularly tested for COVID-19 in line with government guidance.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of coronavirus, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.
