Summary of findings

Overall summary

Ash Tree House is a residential care home providing accommodation for people who require personal care to 53 people at the time of the inspection. The service can support up to 60 people.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The home had designated staff that only worked at this setting.

All visitors temperatures were taken to help screen people for COVID-19.

A pod had been constructed with a perspex screen for visitors to use. This pod had a separate entrance which meant that visitors did not need to go through the home, which reduced risk. People were also supported to maintain regular contact with loved ones through video calls, telephone calls and visits at the window.

Staff spoke positively about the service and management. One staff member told us, "Yes, it's [the support] been excellent, every day I feel secure."

The home was taking part in regular COVID testing.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.
