Summary of findings

Overall summary

Pulsford Lodge is a care home registered to provide accommodation and personal care to up to 49 people. The home specialises in the care of older people. On the day of the inspection there were 38 people at the home.

We found the following examples of good practice.

Staff had received training and were following up to date guidance in infection prevention and control, to minimise risks to people.

The registered manager had maintained good communication, including regular newsletters, with people and their friends and relatives throughout the pandemic. This helped to alleviate people's worries and kept friends and relatives up to date with what was happening in the home.

The home had continued to provide activities and celebrate special occasions to make sure people had social stimulation.

People were able to keep in touch with those who were important to them. There was a comfortable visiting pod where people could see visitors in a safe way. Staff supported people to use video calls to friends and relatives. They had used rapid testing where appropriate, to enable people to have contact with their loved ones.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.
