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Summary of findings

Overall summary

Cranwell Court is a 'care home' providing personal care for up to 56 older people, people with dementia and younger adults in one adapted building over two floors. At the time of our inspection there were 41 people living at the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The home had remodelled rooms to provide changing facilities for staff.

Staff had access to appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and multiple donning and doffing stations were available across the home.

Staff and people using the service were tested regularly for COVID-19 and clear information maintained in relation to when periods of isolation started and finished for both people using the service and staff.

Lateral flow tests were undertaken by relatives prior to visits, they were also provided with appropriate PPE, had temperatures taken and completed health questionnaires.

Furniture in communal areas was arranged to support social distancing and enabling people to use the areas safely.

Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

We received information of concern about infection control and prevention measures at this service. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 23 February 2021 and was announced.
