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# Summary of findings

## Overall summary

Edmund House Care Home is residential home that can accommodate up to 56 people. At the time of the inspection 42 people were using the service.

Edmund House is a purpose built care home, set out over two floors. All bedrooms have en-suite facilities.

We found the following examples of good practice.

Visitors to the service were required to complete a health declaration and lateral flow test on arrival.

Staff were trained on the use of personal protective equipment (PPE). The service had well maintained supplies of PPE with donning and doffing stations in place to ensure staff had access to PPE in a safe and accessible area.

Staff were trained and competent in the knowledge of infection control practices, ensuring the premises were clean and hygienic.

The provider maintained good records for testing and vaccination programmes.

## **Detailed findings**

### Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of the Care Quality Commission's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 26 March 2021 and was announced.
