## Overall summary

The Borrins Care Home is a care home providing personal and nursing care to older people, younger people and people with a physical disability. The service accommodates up to 30 people. At the time of the inspection 15 people were using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The premises were clean and well ventilated.

There was prominent signage and instructions explaining how to meet infection prevention and control standards.

Hand sanitisers and PPE stations were situated throughout the building.

The service had effective processes in place so laundry was managed safely.

Staff were observed wearing appropriate PPE.

The service had robust infection control auditing systems.

## **Detailed findings**

### Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of COVID-19, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 14 July 2021 and was announced.
